# COVID-19 Aruba News bulletin #9



Due to the current situation as to the COVID-19 pandemic, we feel it is important to keep you well informed regarding all announcements, changes and information made available during this time.

In this news bulletin we will provide an update on changes made in personnel registration requirements announced by the Department of Labor & Research (DAO).

### Personnel Register COVID-2020

On July 9, 2020 the Department of Labor & Research (DAO) announced that it has now become a requirement for companies to submit all registered personnel of COVID-2020 by August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

The 'register for personnel COVID-2020' consists of three distinct parts; Model 1A, Model 1B and Model 1C:

- Model 1A is a register including all employees working/registered for the period of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 up to and including June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020;
- Model 1B is a register of the demand for personnel for the period of July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 up to and including December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020;
- Model 1C is a register of the demand for personnel for specific project for the period of July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 up to and including December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020.

Note that it is mandatory to fill out all three sections of the personnel register (Model 1A, 1B and 1C). If the company is not in demand of personnel or personnel for a specific project, the company should fill-in 'nihil' or 'none' on model 1B and model 1C.


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
