


ITA2 Abolition of customs duties on technology products



The customs duties on several technology products have been (further) reduced as of 1 July 2016. The reduction is based on the renewed Information Technology Agreement (ITA), an agreement between the members of the World trade Organization, WTO'.

The previous ITA dates from 1996 and it reduces the customs duties on IT-products such as personal computers, telecommunication devices, semiconductors, software and components of these devices. Due to the fast developments in the field of technology in the previous years, it was necessary to adjust the agreement.

The expansion of the new Information Technology Agreement (ITA2) relates to an expansion of 201 commodity codes/products. All expansions and adjustments could be find in the implementing decree of the European Union: (EU) 2016/1047.

What are the consequences for your business?

- multi printers/scanners;
- remote controls;
- radar devices and components;
- storages;
- switches/electronical securities;
- smartcards/debit cards;
- microscopes, compasses and tools for aeronautics and aerospace;
- lasers and components;
- measure and analytical equipments.
